Protocol: keeping a straight path?



This document provides some guidelines, in the shape of a word cloud, to support the GM in leading the interview. It couldn't be a flowchart, as the various topics interconnect, and is neither definitive nor exhaustive. It is meant to evolve with each session recorded and shared on the *Mosaic*. Although it is best not to take too many notes, as an android would have a more efficient hard drive than our *brain*, the GM can use this document to discreetly mark the topics that have been brought up by the player: indeed, it is preferable to base the android's questioning solely on the player-as-volunteer's words. To that end, it can be useful to frequently rephrase the player-as-volunteer's statements, or try to make out a new definition based on these, in order to create opportunities for the player to correct themselves. However, if the conversation seems to reach a momentary dead-end while some topics *remain* unexplored, the GM-as-android may use sentences such as "*I recall that...*", "*I have been taught that...*": "*It was brought to me that there exists disparities in the way individuals of different sexes experience pleasure. Can you tell me more about that hypothesis?*"

Do not hesitate to encourage the player-as-volunteer to be specific and to share personal experiences. The goal of the GM-as-android is to explore the most of these themes by building closely on what the player has to say.

Examples of questions per topic

This document is merely meant to give the GM ideas. It is not to be followed by the word, and doesn't have to be used unless the GM-as-android is in need of support and ideas. All those topics can be viewed to revolve around the concept of humanity.

Sex/Gender

- ★ Which realities do you refer to by using the words "man" and "woman"?
- ★ What clues do you base on to identify the gender of a potential partner?
- ★ How do you know which gender you are?
- ★ When and how have you determined your sexual orientation?

Reproduction

- ★ Can humans engage in sexual intercourse without reproductive intent?
- ★ Are there criteria a person must fill in order to be allowed by society to reproduce?
- ★ Does sex have to involve reproductive organs/genitalia?

Pleasure

- ★ Do all humans experience pleasure during sex?
- ★ Is sexual pleasure similar to other satisfactory sensorial experiences, such as eating?
- ★ Can you describe the sensation of pleasure?
- ★ When have you first experienced sexual pleasure?

Emotions

- ★ Is sexual intercourse solely a mechanical activity?
- ★ Which feelings can be attached to sex?
- ★ Can you describe what you feel when you are about to engage in sexual intercourse?

Society

- ★ How do humans learn about sexuality?
- ★ How do humans organize sexual encounters?
- ★ Are there rules regulating the way the people of a given society engage in sexuality?
- ★ Is sexuality related to partnership?

Practices

- ★ Must a sexual encounter be physical?
- ★ What constitutes a sex partner?
- ★ Do you consider your own sexual practices to be deviant?

Desire

- ★ Could you describe the physical and psychological manifestations of desire?
- ★ Do you find desiring pleasant?
- ★ Which aspects of another person are susceptible to cause a desire to engage in sex with them?

Identity

- ★ Is sexuality an important part of a person's perceived self?
- ★ What language is used to describe sexual preferences?
- ★ Have you often felt judgement or discrimination based on your sexual identity?
